BIOGRAPHY

Born Tania Takoh, T'neeya is an Afro-R&B artist born in Douala and raised in Limbe, a small coastal town in Cameroon.

Her Cameroonian father and German mother provided influences at an early age. Her father's love of his guitar and for listening to Makossa and Jazz at home planted musical seeds in her. Not to be outdone, her mum's love for gospel nourished the seeds.

At the age of 13, she started writing music as a hobby in boarding school in Bamenda, a city in the northwestern part of the Central African country. With her school desk among other objects as percussion, she would come up with melodies and rhythms effortlessly and seemingly out of thin air.

T'neeya moved to Berlin right after boarding school and enrolled in university where she studied fashion design. Music kept gnawing at her throughout and a rebel at heart, she eventually succumbed to it, pursuing her dreams after leaving school prematurely, much to her parents' consternation.

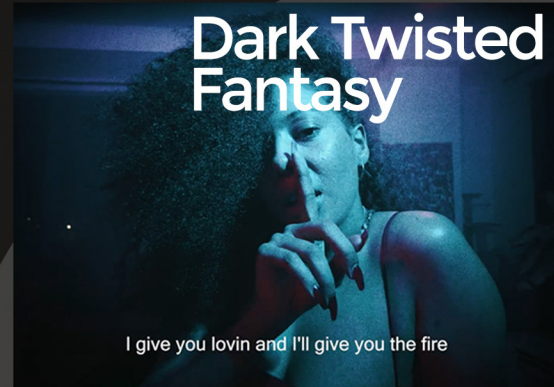
Her fusion of several influences from childhood are central to her making her art.

She has released multiple singles and projects and has been nominated for an Afrima award along the way. T'neeya has been on top playlists on BBC, appeared in the "Afrobeat" documentary on Netflix, and performed on various stages like Afrochella (now Afrofuture), Berlin's African Food Festival, Afronation and many more.

She has been featured on Okay Africa, curated playlists for Apple, appeared on local blogs across Africa and is supported by radio stations all over the continent.
